Invitation to Participate

On behalf of Wits University, the South African Children's Cancer Study Group, CCI and SIOP Africa, we would like to invite you to partner with us in hosting a world class conference in Johannesburg.

The Société Internationale d'Oncologie Pédiatrique/International Society of Paediatric Oncology (SIOP) was formed in 1969 by a small group of specialists at the Institut Gustave-Roussy (IGR) in Paris, with a mission to advance the study and care of children with cancer. This mission has expanded to embrace the advancement of basic research as well as clinical studies, the inclusion of nurses, other health professionals and parents, and the organisation of teaching and outreach programmes.

SIOP is a truly global, multifaceted organisation and the only global multidisciplinary society entirely devoted to paediatric and adolescent cancer. The society has over 2,600 members worldwide, 450 of whom are based in Africa.

University of the Witwatersrand and the South African Children's Cancer Study Group

The University of the Witwatersrand (Wits) is a highly respected university, both on the African continent and world wide. The Wits Paediatric Oncology division encompasses Chris Hani Baragwanath Academic Hospital, Charlotte Maxeke Johannesburg Academic Hospital and Wits Donald Gordon Medical Centre (Mediclinic).

The South African Association of Paediatric Haematology Oncology (SAAPHO) is a professional society that welcomes all professionals involved in the care of childhood cancer in South Africa.

The multidisciplinary team responsible for childhood cancer care includes paediatric oncologists, paediatric surgeons, radiation oncologists, radiologists, ENT surgeons, orthopaedic surgeons, anaesthetists, pharmacists, speech therapists, audiologists, nurses, transplant physicians and allied health professionals, psychosocial support staff and rehabilitation practitioners.

International Society of Paediatric Oncology (SIOP) Africa

SIOP Africa is a branch of SIOP, the largest paediatric oncology organisation globally. SIOP fosters rigorous scientific research to address and reduce the inequalities in childhood cancer services. SIOP works closely with the World Health Organisation, World Child Cancer, the International Paediatric Surgery Society (IPSO) and the Paediatric Radiation Oncology Society (PROS) to better the treatment outcome of children with cancer around the world. SIOP holds an annual congress that provides a platform to present research and share knowledge about effective ways of managing cancers in children, while SIOP Africa holds a similar continental congress every second year. In May 2024, SIOP Africa is organising the 15th congress under the theme "**Towards 2030**".












Why this theme?

Every year, over 400 000 children and adolescents are diagnosed with cancer worldwide. In many African countries, children with cancer have a survival rate as low as 20% while the five year survival rates in regions such as the USA and Europe are above 80%. Despite significant advances, cancer management remains challenging in Africa where cancer treatment and research resources, awareness levels and expertise are limited. Through these annual congresses, health professionals and survivors from various countries meet to share the latest scientific findings, network and create collaborative projects.

Additionally, it is an opportunity for participants to introduce their products, network, and identify potential individuals or organisations they can work with to improve cancer care in their regions.

This year's theme, "Towards 2030" draws inspiration from the WHO Global Initiative for Childhood Cancer (GICC) which aims to raise survival rates worldwide to above 60%. The GICC focuses attention on childhood cancer as a global health imperative, with increased attention and spending in both the private and state healthcare sectors.






